What does the County Communications team do?

The <u>County Communications team</u> promotes Multnomah County's services, elected officials and employees. Provides timely news and information for county residents and journalists.

Internship Description:

We have an opportunity for candidates studying journalism with an emphasis in photojournalism. The work would be located in and around downtown Portland.

Responsibilities include:

- People skills: A candidate must be able to communicate well and create rapport with members of the public, County employees and elected officials in order to create storytelling images.
- Team work: A candidate should be able to understand in advance what images will work to illustrate each story assignment by collaborating with team members who are writers and by following the manager's direction.
- Punctuality: A candidate should show up on time for assignments.





- Schedule flexibility: A candidate may have to cover events on weekends and early evenings.
- Event photography skill: A candidate will photograph a wide variety of
 events such as community events, parades, etc. A candidate also needs
 to prepare to take group photos of the public with county officials and
 employees from each event.
- Discretion: Unlike journalists, a candidate may have to obtain written permission from some clients and must follow all County rules for ethics and health privacy protections.

Equipment: The Communications Office can provide one camera and two lenses (24-70mm/F2.8 and 70-200mm/F2.8).

Qualifications:

- Coursework in journalism, communications, and/or photography
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Organized and detail oriented
- Ability to both follow directions and work independently with minimal supervision
- Flexible, cooperative, and able to adapt and thrive in a changing environment.
- Knowledge of customer service best practices including communicating in a positive manner, using plain language, and being person-centered and culturally responsive.
- Ability to work cooperatively and develop effective working relationships with diverse work groups in a dynamic environment
- Ability to honor research ethics and standards of confidentiality regarding County projects and data
