Case processing


In the first quarter of 2022, cases left MCJRP about as quickly as they entered. But a large backlog remains.



The rate of MCJRP prison sentences fell by about half following the start of the pandemic.




There were relatively even sentencing outcomes across race and gender in the first quarter of 2022.
