PROCLAMATION NO. 2023-024

Proclaiming April 28, 2023 as Workers' Memorial Day in Multnomah County, Oregon.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- A. Workers' Memorial Day is a day to remember those who have suffered and died on the job and rededicate ourselves to the fight for safe workplaces.
- B. We remember those who have died in workplace catastrophes, suffered diseases due to exposure to toxic substances or been injured because of dangerous conditions.
- C. The core theme for Workers' Memorial Day has been "Mourn for the dead, fight for the living."
- D. April 28th has been chosen as Workers' Memorial Day in 2023 because it is the anniversary of when the Occupational Safety and Health Act went into effect.
- E. The Northwest Oregon Labor Council will have a remembrance ceremony at 9:30 am at Fire Station 21.
