	<b>SPONSOR MEETING OUTCOME</b>	<b>NEXT STEPS</b>
<b>Core Funding: Annual Cost of Living Increase</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All current funders agreed to include an annual cost of living increase on core funding levels starting in FY16</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SUN staff will help establish a consistent cost of living rate for FY16 and funders will include that in budgets</li> </ul>
<b>Core Funding: Differentiated Funding Levels</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Many sponsors expressed support for the idea and interest in what their portion of the cost might be.</li> <li>Mayor's Office was only sponsor to name this explicitly as a priority for this year</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SUN staff will develop a proposal for differentiated levels that could be considered this year or incorporated into the FY17 budget in alignment with the RFP</li> </ul>
<b>Principal Leadership Development and Support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All districts agreed to work on this jointly. With efforts to begin in late Winter/Spring 2015</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At the February SUN Districts Council, district liaisons and SUN staff will begin planning</li> </ul>
<b>Attendance Supports</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All 6 districts and United Way identified attendance supports as among their top 2-3 priorities for joint effort</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SUN staff are working with districts to identify which schools to expand a final attendance model to - and what contributions they can make to the budget items (SUN capacity &amp; case workers)</li> <li>An expansion subgroup of Communities Supporting Youth will meet Jan-Mar to define the model to use and what training and support is needed</li> </ul>
<b>Culturally Specific Youth Case Management/Advocacy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4 districts (Centennial, Gresham-Barlow, PPS and Reynolds), the Mayor's Office and United Way prioritized this item</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SUN staff work with districts, the City and County to determine what model and level of contribution are of interest</li> </ul>
<b>New SUN Community Schools</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 districts were interested in new SUN sites (Gresham Barlow, Parkrose, and Reynolds)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SUN staff work with districts on contributions</li> </ul>
