Interstate 5 Bridge Deck Rehabilitation Project Starts Soon

Project description

The Oregon Department of Transportation will repair and resurface two ramps at the Interstate 5 Morrison Bridge interchange and the I-5 bridge over the Rose Quarter Transit Center.

The project will also replace the median barrier along I-5 from the Rose Quarter to north of the Hawthorne Bridge. The new barrier will be 10 inches taller than the existing barrier to improve the safety of the highway.

Project need

The ramps and bridge deck are showing cracks and wheel ruts. The repairs are necessary for the safety of users and to preserve the lifetime of the structures.

Construction begins in June 2017 and is expected to be completed in fall 2017.

The schedule is subject to change based on weather and site conditions.

Nighttime impacts

Nighttime construction activities are necessary to minimize traffic impacts and keep daytime traffic flowing on the heavily traveled freeway.

Lane and ramp closures will take place at night from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on weekdays and from 11 p.m. to 9 a.m. on weekends. There will be no daytime lane or ramp closures.
