Proclaiming November 4, 2024, as Election Hero Day in Multnomah County.

- A. Election Hero Day is an opportunity to honor and show our appreciation for the essential contributions our Election Workers make to our democracy and electoral process here in Multnomah County.
- B. This day also gives us an opportunity to bring awareness to the intimidation, harassment, and attacks that have occurred towards Election Workers around the country for the last few years. We acknowledge these attacks are harmful and create undue stress and trauma for all Election Workers.
- C. We acknowledge that our ability to provide fair, accessible, accurate, and transparent elections depends on the service of these dedicated Election Workers. They truly are upholding our democracy with their service to Multnomah County voters.
- D. Today, we honor and affirm our commitment to providing a respectful and safe workplace for our Election Workers, while also working alongside our partners and other jurisdictions to ensure our workers will be protected from intimidation and harassment while performing their essential Election administration duties.
