RESOLUTION NO. 2025-061**

Authorizing Reduction or Waiver of Land Use Planning Fees.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- A. On April 13, 2000, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 944 establishing that land use services fees would be set by resolution.
- B. The Board adopted Resolution 2025-043 on June 12, 2025, which adopted County Land Use Planning Fees to apply in fiscal year 2026. County Land Use Planning Fees for fiscal year 2026 fees were raised 54%, which represents a substantial increase over fiscal year 2025.
- C. Substantial fee increases disproportionately affect certain community members.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

- 1. The Planning Director may waive or reduce the Land Use Planning fees set forth in Resolution 2025-043. Requests for fee waivers must be in writing and will be reviewed using procedures and criteria established by the Planning Director.
- 2. This Resolution takes effect on October 30, 2025.
