PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

AIR CARGO WAY MULTI-USE PATH
Construct a 12-foot wide Multi-Use Path (MUP) on the north side of NE Air Cargo Way.
Approximate length of this segment of the MUP is 1,100 feet. Improvements include earthwork, concrete curbing, asphalt paving, storm drain improvements, and signing/striping.

P1 AND P2 GARAGE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE UPGRADES

Provide new wayfinding signage in select areas of the P1 (short-term) and P2 (long-term) parking garages and the North and South pedestrian tunnels. Work also includes painting walls.

HILLSBORO AIRPORT

TAXIWAY A REHABILITATION

\$14,200,000

Reconstruct nearly the full length of Taxiway A, as well as the connecting Taxiways A6, A8, A9 and a portion of Taxiway B. Improvements include full-depth reconstruction, pavement rehabilitation, and all associated electrical and storm drainage work. Work will be performed in partnership with the FAA and coordinated with Port of Portland Operations.

MARINE TERMINAL 4

T4 ELECTRICAL REPLACEMENTS

\$1,000,000

Reroute electric feeder and replace medium-voltage equipment.

T4 BASIN M STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS

\$650,000

Construct stormwater infiltration basin and associated infrastructure.

MARINE TERMINAL 6

T6 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

\$1,500,000

Reconstruction and rehabilitate nearly 9 acres of pavement at T6. Improvements include full-depth roadway reconstruction, asphalt mill and inlay, and chip seal of existing asphalt.

PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

NEW KENNEDY FEEDER

\$3,000,000

Construct the new Kennedy 12.47 KV electrical feeder from the point-of-service on the NE corner of the intersection of NE 47th Ave and NE Cornfoot Way to a new vault located on the airfield south of Taxiway C and east of Taxiway J.

P1 AND P2 PARKING MODIFICATIONS

\$1,270,000

Modify Levels 1 and 2 of the P1 (short-term) garage, and Level 1 of the P2 (long-term) garage. Modifications include demolition of existing kiosks, barriers and other equipment; removing existing striping and re-striping; providing new wayfinding signage; and providing new automated entry/exit gate controls.

MARINE TERMINAL 6

T6 LIGHTING AND ELECTRICAL REPLACEMENTS

\$5,000,000

Replace high-mast lighting fixtures and some poles as well as associated electrical systems at Berths 603, 604, 605 and 606.
