I've lived in Fairview for almost 30 years and served my city most of this time as a mayor, city councilor, school board member, and planning commissioner.

I love my city, and proud to literally get it on the map. Years ago, when I was mayor, I convinced the county to change the name of 213th Avenue to Fairview Parkway, so that anyone driving along I-84 would know who we are. I created a monthly roundtable meeting for business owners, and held community meetings at mobile home parks, apartment buildings, and our community center in Old Town. I also improved street lights and our parks, including leading the effort to build the gazebo at Park Cleone.

I'm running again for city council out of concern and with hope. I'm concerned about the lack of communication and collaboration at city hall and I'm hopeful I can bridge the gap between elected officials and the community they serve. I want everyone's hard-earned tax dollars to go towards projects that are needed to keep us safe and improve our quality of life.

If I am elected I will:

- Connect and communicate with the public by holding meetings out in the community
- Tackle the increase in crime by hiring an additional sheriff's deputy to patrol our streets
- Revisit priorities and rebuild the city budget to make the most of scarce resources

My opponent once quit his City of Fairview council service. I promise to never quit on you. I hope to have your vote and the privilege of working for and with you again.
