Basically, a move away from cultural proficiency to cultural safety or even cultural humility. Please note, cultural awareness and it's other equity terms is on a continuum not a final step. The BIPOC subcommittee is currently in a work in progress and don't have officially have a final recommendation 							
	yet." o "I have no suggested changes to this document. I believe that it appropriately focuses on marginalized communities first which have							
	been underserved and have experienced health inequities as a result of systems."							
	 Current language of #8 Guidance in Question: "8. Services will be effective, linguistically appropriate, fully understandable by the client, trauma informed, and respectful of the client's beliefs. Providers will provide culturally proficient services to clients of all socio economic backgrounds, all races and ethnicities, all educational levels, all sexual orientations, all ages and all genders – including transgender or gender non-conforming individuals." Question – do we want to change? 							
	Other language could be "culturally appropriate," "culturally responsive,"							
	"practicing cultural humility"							
	 Cultural safety is an outcome based on respectful engagement that recognizes and strives to address power imbalances inherent to health care. It results in an 							

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	 environment free of racism and discrimination where people feel safe when receiving care. What is the proposed language? Don't want to wordsmith during the meeting, usually give comments to HGAP staff, they bring back suggested language for vote Process check – are we making this decision now? Propose we defer to the BIPOC Committee, would be most interested in hearing what they recommend. Decision: defer this to BIPOC Committee to come up with wording and bring it back to the committee
