Project Purpose

- To repair and restore the roadway surface and bridge deck joints.
- Improve bike and pedestrian facilities for enhanced safety and accessibility.

Impact:

- Extend the lifespan of the Hawthorne Bridge, reducing maintenance costs over time.
- Improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians, encouraging active transportation.
- Contribute to a sustainable and resilient urban infrastructure.

Timeline:

• Onsite construction: April to October 2024



Public Engagement

- BPCAC meeting in January 2023
- Project mailers were sent to businesses and residents within 500 ft of project area in September 2023.

- Issues or concerns with staging impacts
- Preferred buffer width between bike lane and traffic lane






- Slip-form paver will be used for the overlay
- Directional closures during non-peak hours
 WB - 2 pm to 5 am
 EB - 7 pm to 11 am
 - EB 7 pm to 11 am
- Requires detour of bicycle facilities
- No significant detours for pedestrians




























Bicycle Lane Buffer Width





Bicycle Slip Lane




