#### Guides Annual Service Plans.



### What's in the service concept?

- <30% more service.
- An expanded Frequent Network.
- More local services running every 20 or 30 minutes.
- Expanded weekend service.
- New lines serving areas that are far from transit today.
- Reduced service to some low-demand, mostly higher-income areas.



#### Where did these ideas come from?

Many of the ideas come from TriMet's Service Enhancement Plans (2011-2016).

The Forward Together "Transit Existing Conditions Report" added more recent data and insights.

Municipal staffs helped us with an earlier draft.



# FY24 in East Multnomah County

- Line 77 (Halsey) will be upgraded to Frequent Service
- Line 77 will have select trips extended to TRIP aligned with shift times
- Line 87 (Airport Way / 182<sup>nd</sup>) will be upgraded to Frequent Service




# **FY25 Proposal Overview**

- 34 total lines
  - 30 current lines & 4 new lines
- 2 new Frequent Service lines
- 9 frequency or span upgrades
- 7 lines discontinued or replaced

- We're proposing to extend Line 25 on Glisan St to Reynolds High School and Mt. Hood Community College with buses coming more often, for more hours of the day, every day.
- Line 80 and Line 81 would be combined on 257th Dr between Troutdale Reynolds Industrial Park and Gresham and with new weekend service; Glenn Otto Park service would be discontinued due to low ridership.
  - Line 24 and Line 21 service would merge via Sandy Blvd to improve connections between Gresham, the Parkrose Transit Center, and inner Portland.
