The Community Mental Health Programs (CMHP) is housed at the Behavioral Health Division of the Multnomah County Health Department. CMHP acts as safety net services for community members who are impacted by severe and persistent mental illness. Programs include Crisis Services, Residential Services, Adult Protective Services, Court Diversion Programs, the Behavioral Health Resource Center, Older Adult Behavioral Health, and Commitment Services.
