**Program Characteristics:****Program Description**

The Child Support Enforcement Unit works to ensure that children receive consistent financial support from legally responsible parents. By establishing, modifying, and enforcing child support orders, the unit helps promote family stability and economic security for thousands of children across Multnomah County.

The unit balances accountability with problem-solving approaches, recognizing that some parents face barriers to meeting their obligations. When appropriate, prosecutors work with the courts and community partners to connect parents to employment assistance, substance use treatment, and mental health services that support long-term compliance and family stability.

The Child Support Enforcement Unit also partners in Oregon's Child Support Deferred Sentencing program, which uses a team-based approach to help parents achieve stability and maintain consistent support for their children. Through collaboration with courts, community organizations, and partner agencies, the unit supports durable outcomes that benefit children and families.

**Equity Statement**

The Child Support Enforcement Unit promotes equitable outcomes by ensuring fair application of child support laws while recognizing barriers faced by parents with limited resources. By connecting parents to supportive services and emphasizing sustained compliance, the unit works to reduce economic disparities and improve stability for children and families.
