

WHAT IS MEASURE 11?

Measure 11 is the law in Oregon. This law says:

...IF you are 15 or older, and
...IF you do any of 24 crimes

YOU GO TO COURT AS AN ADULT!

21 of these crimes will...

MOST LIKELY GET YOU LOCKED UP

The other 3 crimes will....

PROBABLY GET YOU LOCKED UP

WHY DOES OREGON HAVE THIS LAW?

Many Oregonians voted for this law:

THEY ARE...

...Tired of crime

...Tired of ANYONE (including juveniles) getting away with crime

THEY WANT TO...

...Feel safe

...Be safe from violent crimes

...Lock up ANYONE (including juveniles) who commits certain crimes

WHO ARE YOU TALKING ABOUT...

MURDERERS?

YES...Murder and Aggravated Murder will send a 15-year-old to prison. **BUT...**

There are 22 more crimes that WILL MOST LIKELY send a 15-year-old to a lock up program or prison for a long time!

DOING A CRIME MEANS BIG TIME!

These are examples of Measure 11 crimes that will send you to prison:

ROBBERY I: You use a baseball bat, a gun, or a knife against someone to steal their bike. **You will go to prison and could be there for 7 years, 6 months.**

ROBBERY II: You tell someone you have a gun and to give you their money. The person believes you have a gun, even if you don't, and gives you their money. **You will go to prison and could be there for 5 years and 10 months.**

SEXUAL ABUSE I: You are babysitting or playing with a small child. You have sexual contact with them by touching their penis, vaginal area, or anus, or by making them touch you in those same places. **You will go to prison and could be there for 6 years and 3 months.**

ASSAULT II: You physically injure someone on purpose with a gun, a knife, a bat, or some other weapon. **You will go to prison and could be there for 5 years, 10 months.**

MANSLAUGHTER II: You are driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. You cause an accident and someone dies. **You will go to prison and could stay there for 6 years, 3 months.**

IF FOUND GUILTY OF ANY OF THESE 21 MEASURE 11 CRIMES YOU WILL **DEFINITELY GO** TO PRISON AND YOU COULD STAY THERE FOR:

KEEP READING 

IS THE CRIME WORTH YOUR FUTURE?

IF I'M WITH SOMEONE AND THEY DO ONE OF THESE CRIMES, I WON'T GET IN TROUBLE...RIGHT?

WRONG! If you help that person in any way like:

- ...Telling them to commit the crime
- ...Helping them plan the crime
- ...Being a lookout

YOU COULD GET LOCKED UP TOO!

INSTEAD:

- ...Try to talk them out of it. IF THAT DOESN'T WORK...
- ...Leave right away
- ...Get some help to stop the crime

WON'T THE JUDGE GIVE ME A BREAK IF I'VE NEVER BEEN IN TROUBLE BEFORE?

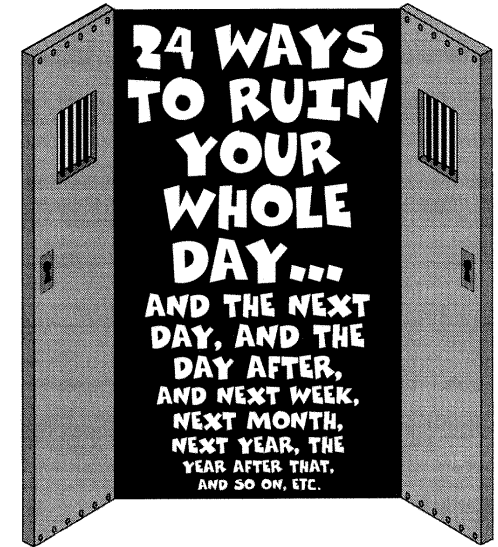
IN MANY CASES, NO! These are all serious crimes and Measure 11 often requires that ANYONE, including juveniles, be locked up for a long time if they are 15 or older and guilty of any of the 24 Measure 11 crimes.
