V. Director's Comments:

Chuck Beasley, Multnomah County Senior Planner, informed the commissioners that Julie Cleveland resigned from the Planning Commission, effective April 28, 2011. A search for her replacement will commence shortly, with an emphasis on someone from Sauvie Island or vicinity.

The Urban & Rural Reserves should be going before LCDC in August 2011. This hearing will consider the region's response to the oral LCDC remand that approved reserves designations in Clackamas and Multnomah Counties, and rejected a portion of the reserves designations in Washington County.
