Other communities across the US are duplicating this innovative and unusual partnership.

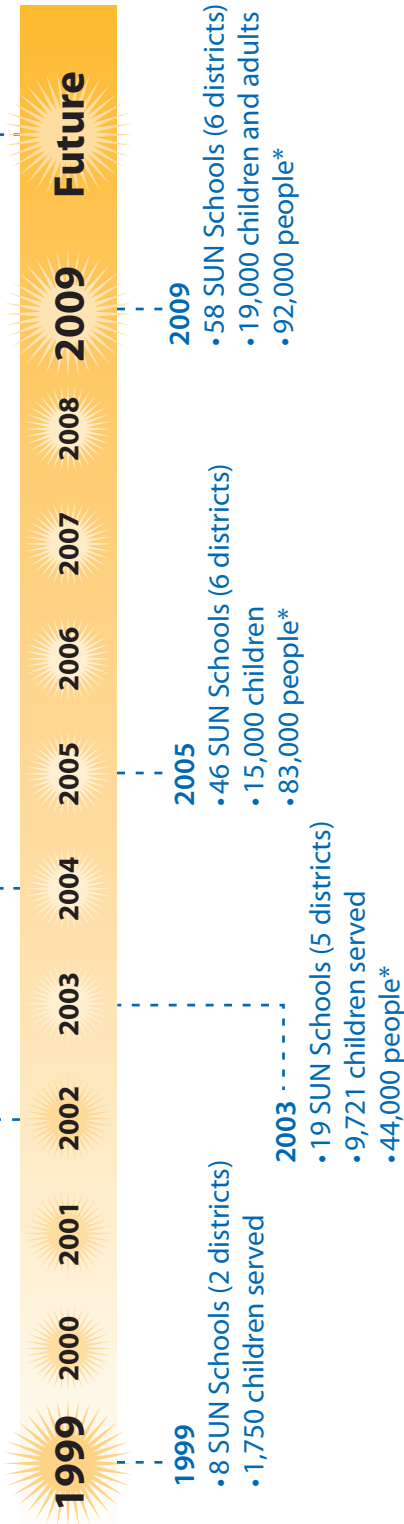
