
HRS S&O - Parking Lot

 - c. Include KPI regarding long-term placement in shelter
 - d. Discuss KPI around prevention
- Provide committee members with information about what adequate shelter supply means versus shelter available now and a gap analysis of shelter.

 Southeast 1




HRS CAC - Membership Gaps
