

Office of Community Involvement Community Budget Advisory Application - FY 25-26

Community Budget Advisory Committees (CBACs) are groups of community members that confer with department leaders and staff about departmental budgets and operations. CBACs are one of the key ways that the county receives community input on its budget priorities. CBAC volunteers hear directly from department directors and other staff about the county's programs and services. The requirements for CBAC membership are:

- that you have an interest in the programs and budget process of the County;
- that you are available to attend meetings and participate in deliberations (most CBACs meet monthly, with more meetings during budget season).
- that you are not a current employee of Multnomah County

No budgeting or financial expertise is necessary! CBAC members do not go line by line through the County budget. Meetings are focused on the bigger picture - understanding the County's programs and services, discussing challenges and opportunities that departments are considering in their budget process, and providing their perspectives about the budget decisions for the next year.
