Confirming Interim Designation for Multnomah County Sheriff.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Multnomah County Charter Section 4.50(3) and Multnomah County Code 5.003 require that elected officials designate an interim occupant to serve until a vacancy is filled.
- b. Charter Section 4.10 states the qualifications for County officers and Code Section 5.003(B)(4) requires that the designee meet the Charter qualifications for appointees of such offices.
- c. Nicole Morrisey O'Donnell, Multnomah County Sheriff, designates Chief Deputy Robert Stewart as interim occupant of that office in the event of a vacancy.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

The Board confirms Robert Stewart to serve as interim occupant for the Multnomah County Sheriff in the event of a vacancy in that office.
