### **Ballots for May 18 Primary Election to be mailed today**

The U.S. Postal Service will begin processing ballots to be mailed in Multnomah County for the May 18 Primary Election—approximately 404,000 of them.

Registered voters should receive their ballots by May 6. Voters who have not gotten their ballots by then should call the Multnomah County Elections Division at (503) 988-3720.

Voters can mail their voted ballot back for one first class stamp or drop off their ballots at any official drop site until 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election.
