### **April 27 is the voter registration deadline for May 18 election**

The May 18 primary election is fast approaching. [Multnomah County Elections](http://www.co.multnomah.or.us/elections) today reminds voters that Tuesday, April 27 is the voter registration and party affiliation change deadline for this election.

For the first time, Oregon voters may now register to vote online at [www.oregonvotes.org](http://www.oregonvotes.org). To register online, an eligible voter must have a valid Oregon driver's license, permit or ID card. The system allows new registrations, changes in party registration and changes in address. Voters already registered will not have to re-register.

Deadlines to register on that day are as follows: 6:00 p.m. at the Multnomah County Elections office, a USPS postmark of April 27 for mail submission or online registration at [www.oregonvotes.org](http://www.oregonvotes.org) by 11:59 p.m.
