Ordinance No. 1

An Ordinance proclaiming election results and establishing government of Multnomah County under Charter.

WHEREAS, by a majority vote of the people of Multnomah County, Oregon, there was adopted at the primary election of May 24, 1966, a County Charter for the organization of the government of Multnomah County as drafted and filed with the County Clerk of Multnomah County by the lawfully constituted Home Rule Charter Committee appointed under the provisions of ORS 203.730 to 203.740; and

WHEREAS at the general election held in Multnomah County, Oregon, November 8, 1966, there was elected by the legal voters of Multnomah County under said Charter five County Commissioners and a County Auditor, hereinafter named, as shown by the canvass of votes and certificates of election made and issued by the Registrar of Elections of Multnomah County; and

It appearing to the Board that the Commissioners so elected have filed their respective oaths of office as County Commissioners and official bonds and have duly qualified for the following positions and terms of office as members of the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon, as follows:

Position No. 1	M. James Gleason	Four year term (Chairmanship of Board of County Commissioners)
Position No. 2	L. W. Aylsworth	Two year term
Position No. 3	David Eccles	Four year term
Position No. 4	Dan Mosee	Two year term
Position No. 5	Mel Gordon	Four year term;

and

It further appearing that John J. O'Donnell has duly qualified for the position of County Auditor by the filing of an

oath of office and official bond for a term of four years:

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The elected county officials above named be and they are hereby declared the official office holders for the respective positions to which they have been elected by the legal voters of Multnomah County in the government of Multnomah County under the provisions of the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter.

Section 2. Effective 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966, the organization of the government of Multnomah County, Oregon, shall be that established and provided under the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter heretofore adopted by the legal voters of Multnomah County at the primary election on May 24, 1966 pursuant to the constitution and laws of the State of Oregon.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
