Ordinance No. 7

An Ordinance placing the Department of Public Works in operation and assigning its functions.

WHEREAS, by the provisions of Chapter VI, section 6.20 of the Multnomah County Charter, a department of public works was established in the government of Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to set this department in operation immediately,

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The department of public works is hereby set in operation effective 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966.

Section 2. The head of the department of public works shall be known as "Director of the Department of Public Works", and shall be a qualified registered professional engineer.

Section 3. The functions, duties and responsibilities of the county roadmaster under state law are hereby assigned and vested in the Director of the Department of Public Works.

Section 4. The department of public works is hereby assigned the following functions and duties:

1. Construction, maintenance and operation of the roads and bridges of the county.
2. Maintenance and upkeep of all county motorized equipment.
3. Design and construction of county buildings.
4. Upkeep and maintenance of all county buildings and county sewage facilities.
5. Provide engineering plans and reports required under County Service District laws.

6. Operation of county sanitary fills.

7. Supervision and control of operations of county service districts.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
