Ordinance No. 5

An Ordinance placing the Department of Judicial Administration in operation and assigning its functions.

WHEREAS, by the provisions of Chapter VI, section 6.20 of the county charter, a department of judicial administration was established in the government of Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to set this department in operation immediately,

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The department of judicial administration is hereby set in operation effective 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966.

Section 2. The department of judicial administration shall have the clerical and ministerial functions prescribed by state law for the county clerk, district court clerk, sheriff and constable with reference to administration of the courts, except the service and execution of court orders in criminal and quasi-criminal cases.

Section 3. The functions, duties and responsibilities under state law of the county clerk, district court clerk, sheriff and constable herein transferred to the department of judicial administration shall be considered vested in the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Article VI, section 10, of the Oregon Constitution.

Section 4. The head of the department of judicial administration shall be known as the "Director of the Department of Judicial Administration" and is authorized to appoint such deputy directors and clerks of the circuit and district courts within the department as may be required for the proper handling of the functions assigned to the department of judicial administration.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
