Ordinance No. 2

An Ordinance placing the Department of Finance in operation and assigning its functions.

WHEREAS, by the provisions of Chapter VI, section 6.20 of the county charter a department of finance was established in the government of Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to set this department in operation immediately,

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The department of finance is hereby set in operation effective 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966.

Section 2. The department of finance shall have, exclusive of the functions of the auditor prescribed by the charter, the functions prescribed by state law for the auditor, the treasurer, the assessor, and the sheriff as tax collector, as well as the functions of the county concerning management of its property.

Section 3. The head of the department of finance shall be known as the "Director of the Department of Finance".

Section 4. The functions, duties and responsibilities under state law of the auditor, treasurer, assessor and sheriff herein transferred to the department of finance shall be considered vested in the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Article VI, section 10, of the Oregon Constitution.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an

emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
