ORDINANCE NO. 13

An Ordinance providing for the granting of retirement benefits to circuit court bailiffs and amending Article II, Section (2), subsection (b) of Ordinance No. 12.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article II, Section (2) (b) of Multnomah County Retirement Ordinance No. 12 be and the same is hereby amended, effective 12:00 o'clock midnight, December 31, 1966, to read as follows:

(b) Regular employees of the county, including non-elected officers, official court reporters, circuit court bailiffs, and deputy district attorneys although their entire salaries have not been paid by the county, provided that such deputy district attorneys receive more than 50 per cent of their salaries from the county.

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
