ORDINANCE NO. 21

An Ordinance providing for the exemption of circuit court employees from classified civil service and amending Article IV, Section (5), of Ordinance No. 10.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article IV, Section (5), of Multnomah County Civil Service Ordinance No. 10 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(5) Employees directly attached to the operation of the Circuit Court courtroom and limited to bailiffs, reporters, court clerks, criers, secretaries, law clerks and employees required in the operation of the Court Administrator's Office, as established in ORS 8.070, including the secretaries required for the docket control in the General Trial, Domestic Relations and Probate Courts."

Section 2. Court employees having civil service status on the effective date of the amending ordinance shall not lose any rights thereunder.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
