23-25 JUSTICE REINVESTMENT GRANT AMENDMENT REQUESTS LPSCC

The Justice Reinvestment Grant seeks to reduce prison reliance by reinvesting avoided costs in local communities. The 23 -25 Multnomah County Justice Reinvestment Program (MCJRP) applies these funds to an informed sentencing process. MCJRP allows individuals facing presumptive prison sentences to participate in an assessment process that informs final sentencing.

GRANT AMENDMENTS

1) Multnomah Defenders, Inc (MDI) Contract: Move \$67,800 from Case Manager position to Social Work Position (Effective July 1, 2025)

Background/Justification

- The JRP Competitive Grant funds a defense-based social worker and case manager at MDI to work with MCJRP eligible women and young men of color. These positions support early stabilization and treatment engagement prior to sentencing.
- MDI requested two social work positions in their original grant budget.
 When the positions were not fully funded through the grant, MDI
 re-classified one position to a Case Manager at a lower rate. The
 Case Manager position was not filled until January, 2024, resulting in
 six months vacancy savings. The adjustments will bring both
 positions closer to the market rate.

2) Move \$8225.99 from LPSCC Administrative Costs to Personnel. (Effective July 1, 2025)

Justification

• LPSCC administrative costs were budgeted to the grant higher than the LPSCC rate in the original application. The reallocation exhausts 23-25 grant funds before accessing 25-27 grant funds for the LPSCC
