Cost Savings

The more sustainable brand of bathroom papers will actually save the County:

\$ 9,832.01 in six months.

\$ 19,664.02 in one year.

Sustainability Benefits

Using paper made with a higher percentage of recycled content will:



Save 424 trees a year.



Reduce 131 tons of Carbon a year.



Save 141 barrels of oil a year.



Cost Savings

Central Stores researched more sustainable paper options for bathroom paper products such as hand towels and bathroom tissue.

They determined that a brand that offers higher recycled content and will also save the County over \$19,000 per year.

Sustainability

Choosing paper products with higher **recycled content**, reduces the amount of trees, oil, energy and water used to make the paper.

The new paper products come from a state registered Minority-owned, Woman-owned, Emerging Small Business (MWESB) located in the Pacific Northwest.
