## TriMet Pass Program

Multnomah County encourages employees to utilize public transportation. There is **no cost** to employees – but you must be a benefits eligible employee to qualify for a TriMet Annual Pass. The pass is equivalent to an All-Zone TriMet bus pass and is acceptable on TriMet buses, MAX, Wes, Streetcar, Tram and C-Tran non-express routes.

### How to get your TriMet Pass

#### **Step 1: Get a Tri-Met Photo ID Card**

1. If you are a new hire, check the box on your county ID photo paperwork authorizing the use of your photo for a TriMet pass. OR
2. Submit your own electronic photo: Email your photo in jpeg format to [employee.benefits@multco.us](mailto:employee.benefits@multco.us)

\*It can take up to a week to get your TriMet ID card. When your card is available, we will send you an email.

#### **Step 2: Validation Sticker**

Pick up or bring your TriMet photo ID card to the Benefits Office in the Multnomah Building for a validation sticker. **You must get your validation sticker in person.**

- When you leave county employment, your bus pass must be surrendered.
- If your pass is lost or stolen, please contact the benefits office to find out what your options are.

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
