









Average Daily Health Dept. Clinic Visits by Payer Mix




November 2008 had a total of 624 average daily visits. Of those, 70% were insured and 30% were not insured.

Type of MCHD Clinic Visits: November 2008



Mental Health Verity Inpatient Days




The County pays an average of \$4,200 per discharge for each Verity only inpatient stay and \$1,100 for Medicare/Verity dual eligibles. The November average length of stay per discharge is 9.84 days.




Notes: OHP data are from October: the State's Medicaid data system changed in December, so updated OHP data will not be available until the December Brief. November showed a 20% decrease in MCHD Clinic Visits (24312 in October), across all visit types; despite the decrease, total number of November visits was near the 12-month average (13584). Dual Eligible Verity bed days per 1000 members sharply increased in November, but again moved nearer to the 12-month average (30.66). Total paid Bed Days were also up, approximately 23% over October, though Verity only bed days were slightly down (increase was in Adult Medicare Primary).




*Mental Health data show a two month time lag as claims may be submitted up to four months after a visit. Monthly data will change slighly with each new update.



Protective Services for Vulnerable Populations




*Each program serves different populations. ADS is responsible for all protective investigations not covered by developmental disability and mental health services, so they have the largest client base.


