

## SAFETY PRIORITY BRIEF: NOVEMBER 2008



**Notes:** Average Daily Arrests decreased by seven arrests per day. Since October, arrests in Gresham for Larceny Auto increased 40% and Robbery decreased 45%. In Portland, Larceny Other decreased 23% and Drug Arrests decreased 25%. Average Length of Stay (ALS) for November was 18.5 days and has continued to rise since June. However, the number of jail beds occupied decreased for the first time since September, to 1,457. Sheriff Standard Bookings have decreased 12% since September; the biggest decrease was in Felony Bookings.



**Notes:** In November, the overall average of cases convicted and not convicted by the DA has been 50% for both categories, although for the current month convictions rose to 63% of the total cases closed. Adult Active Caseload decreased for the second month in a row, to 8,792. Also, Juvenile Justice Caseload by Unit decreased from a total in October of 597 to a total of 581 in November.
