











Notes: The *Other* Arrest category increased for the first time since December; 44 to 46 per day average. The increase in the has been driven by *Bench Warrant Bail Jump* and *Fugitive* charges. The *Other* category for both Arrests and Bookings has consistently been the driver for any increase or decrease in the last eight months. Psych-Alerts (556) are at their highest level since October 2006. The Average Daily Jail Population increased to 1612 in August from 1602 as did Matrix Releases to 108 from 65 the previous month. The jail dorm closure reported last month was incorrect; it was in Multnomah County Detention Center, not Inverness.









Notes: The DA's Office number of cases pending review remained high in August at 353. Since December 2006 the *Other* charge severity (e.g. Infraction, None, Unknown, and Violation, about 3% to 4% of primary charges) in the District Attorney Caseload monthly detail was not being reported properly. The PS Briefs for the incorrect months will be revised and made available online. The Adult and Juvenile Community Supervision Caseloads continue to remain consistent.
