











Notes: The increase in the Other category for Arrests, which started in January, continued and can be attributed to an increase in the number of Fugitive and Bench Warrant Bail Jump charges. Auto theft and Larceny were the main forces driving the increase in index offenses in 2007. Matrix Releases restarted with 36 in April, after two months' zero release.









Notes: April saw a drop in the number of convictions from the previous month; although a larger proportion of these were felonies. Also of note was the increase in Drug related convictions from 18% in March to 24% in April. There was also an increase in the number of Juvenile Community Supervision Caseloads; up from 495 to 508.
