



## **SAFETY PRIORITY BRIEF: JUNE 2006**













**Notes:** Compared to this time last year, Portland reports a 17% reduction in Index offenses and a 19% reduction for Gresham, driven mostly by strong declines in theft and burglary. In both cities however, robbery has increased. Average daily arrests and standard bookings remained unchanged from May. The MCSO reported 246 matrix releases in June (avg. 8.2/day) and the average length of stay (ALS) increased from May (18 days per booking). June's overall jail utilization was 99.6%, leaving only 7 beds available on any given day.









**Notes**: The Adult community supervision caseloads continue to increase and are now at the same level as July 2003 for both *Reduced Supervision Team* and *Community Field Supervision* caseloads. The DA *Adult Caseloads* appeared within normal parameters. *Juvenile Justice Caseloads* remain unchanged from April.
