


PUBLIC SAFETY BRIEF: NOVEMBER 2004





Notes: The average daily reported index offenses increased slightly for GPD, due mainly to increases in auto theft and robbery while PPB remained unchanged overall. GPD and PPB report year-to-date offenses at 3% and 8% lower than 2003, respectively. Average daily booking was the lowest since Jan 2004. The matrix releases were down by over 100 from October, thus averaging 3 fewer per day.
