


PUBLIC SAFETY BRIEF: SEPTEMBER 2004





Notes. The average daily reported index offenses (PDX) declined slightly and overall remains 5% lower than last year due to reductions in nearly all index offenses citywide (PPB report week 40). Reports of residential burglary are still elevated especially in the East and Southeast precincts. Booking rates were average. Matrix releases were down from August.

Notes. The DA adult caseload was consistent with the multiyear average. The active adult supervision caseload declined slightly and appears to have flatted out. The juvenile caseload saw a slight increase due to increases in the number of high and medium-risk cases. The number of medium-risk cases (205) was the highest since December 2002.
