


PUBLIC SAFETY MONTHLY BRIEF: JULY 2003






Notes:

Average daily index crime reports remain above the multi-year average, driven mostly by increases in theft. Average daily bookings continue their decline; currently they are at levels consistent with 1994. Bed availability continues to remains high in June 2003, at 74 beds open on average each day.

Notes:

Cases received for review by the DA has ticked up, while issued cases appear relatively steady. The <u>apparent</u> decline in July's issued cases is due to the pending review of the current month's cases.

Adult supervision levels show a continued decline; a recent increase in medium and high-risk (i.e., non-casebank) cases occurred in July, coinciding with the restoration of court services

Juvenile caseload has show a recent decline, driven by reductions in the high and medium risk caseloads.
