- SUN Service System Coordinating Council -Summary of Charge

This is a summary of the SUN Service System Coordinating Council charge as defined through the recommendations of the School Age Services Task Force.

- 1. **Identify and Prioritize Core Services:** Ensure that County and other public funds are focused on delivery of a set of core services to those at greatest risk of academic failure, and tied by research and best practice to academic achievement, self-sufficiency and successful adulthood.
- 2. **Develop Allocation Formula:** Develop a standard allocation formula and process to distribute County and other public funds within the SUN Service System. The allocation criteria will be used to expand or contract the SUN Service System as the opportunity or need arises.
- 3. Evaluation: Conduct regular measurement of the SUN Service System.
- 4. **Sustainable Funding:** Develop an overall funding strategy for the SUN Service System, including a system development plan.
- 5. **Coordination of Technical Assistance:** Systems represented on the Coordinating Council will jointly provide technical assistance for the SUN Service System providers.
- 6. **Memorandum of Understanding:** Build on the existing Memorandum of Understanding to create a mechanism for supporting the SUN Service System as a means of aligning, coordinating and delivering services across multiple systems.
- 7. **Systems Integration and Alignment:** The City, County, State, and School Districts use the SUN Service System as a delivery mechanism for services to children and families. The Coordinating Council will further consider the structure and purpose of the system, including the roles and responsibilities of individual partners.
