

## **Rule Definitions for INCIDENT REPORTING:**

The County Mental Health Program in each County **is the State designee** for the **delivery and oversight** of all Mental Health Services. Each licensed provider must follow the criteria for incident reporting that has been developed by the county and in accordance with the applicable “license” OAR. All incidents are to reported and reviewed by the residential specialist designee in each county for patterns, areas of concern, reportable licensing violations and or abuse allegations.

Licensing Rules address the following in reference to incident reporting.

### **Residential Treatment Facility:**
