Program Characteristics: One-Time-Only Request

Program Description

Multnomah County serves as both the shelter coordinator for the region and the lead for the MultiAgency Coordination group established by the State during Oregon's Emergency Homelessness Response. As part of its planning and financial responsibilities, the County manages the transfer of state funding to organizations chosen by the state.

These funds are a one-time grant from Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS) specifically designated for shelters managed by the City of Portland.

Equity Statement

Services funded through this program are delivered by highly skilled non-profit partners, which offer services tailored to support vulnerable people experiencing homelessness, especially communities of color, women, families with minor children. The inreach teams include staff from culturally-specific, domestic violence, and behavioral health providers to assist adults. Services are open to all eligible people experiencing homelessness in Multnomah County regardless of protected class.
