Burlington Water District Measure

**26-269
Five-Year Local Option Tax for Fire & Ambulance Operations**

Question: Shall the District create a new five-year levy of \$1.70 per \$1000 of assessed value for five years beginning 2027-2028? This measure creates new local option taxes which may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary: The taxes will be used to meet the expenses Burlington Water District pays for emergency services (Fire and Ambulance) and to maintain a contingency fund for the future increased expenses.

An estimate of the total amount to be raised each fiscal year is:

\$84,420 in 2027-2028
\$86,953 in 2028-2029
\$89,561 in 2029-2030
\$92,248 in 2030-2031
\$95,016 in 2031-2032

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate. A property with an assessed value of \$166,000.00, the average assessed value for the district, will pay an estimated \$24 per month in additional property taxes.
