**Executive Summary** 

The Coalition of Communities of Color in collaboration with Portland State University has collected data that repeatedly demonstrates the disparities experienced by communities of color in Multhomah County in the areas of health and human services, education, employment and housing. This program offer aims to provide funding for the preventive resources and services necessary to improve the quality of life for communities experiencing generational poverty and discrimination.

## **Program Summary**

According to the Communities of Color in Multnomah County: An Unsettling Profile, "Today, the official count is that communities of color comprise 26.3% of the County's numbers and this number is growing much more quickly than that of Whites, due to high fertility rates and migration." Additionally, the report highlights that these growing populations experience higher rates of poverty and worse outcomes for income, poverty, occupation and education. In order to address the challenges faced by these communities, it's critical that we invest in prevention, culturally specific services and poverty reduction strategies.

At the federal level, the Promise Neighborhoods Initiative model is intended to turn neighborhoods of concentrated poverty into neighborhoods of opportunity. By the using the underpinnings of this model as a guide, Multnomah County can identify programs and groups of organizations that are collaborating to provide a continuum of care for youth in communities of color for their academic, emotional, mental and physical health. This ongoing funding will be used to serve youth who have not been adjudicated, but experience poverty and other obstacles experienced by people of color as detailed by the Coalition of Communities of Color.
