**Executive Summary** 

Persons in mental health crisis comprise an ever increasing segment of the inmate population of the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office Jail System. This creates a significant ongoing challenge for corrections supervisors and managers who are tasked with critical decision making responsibilities in emergency and non-emergency situations involving mentally ill persons inmates and members of the public.

## **Program Summary**

This offer will provide for an enhanced twenty four hour training program for corrections managers, supervisors, and deputies assigned to positions both inside and outside of custodial areas of the jails, and who are in regular contact with persons mentally ill or in mental health crisis. This training includes a greater understanding of mental illness, persons in mental health crisis, crisis communications, de-escalation techniques, and working with mental health staff and outside treatment providers in creating, enacting, and maintaining long term care and behavioral plans for individual mentally ill inmates. Staff undergoing this training will be certified and accredited in Mental Health First Aid.

This program offer is part of a broader MCSO plan to bring a parallel level of Crisis Intervention Training to the corrections field as is currently in place in law enforcement.
