Who uses it? The Morrison Bridge is one of the busiest bridges for cars as it connects to Interstates 5 and 84. The bridge was originally built with five-foot sidewalks on both sides but in 2010, the lanes were narrowed and the south sidewalk was widened to create a multi-use path for pedestrians and bicyclists. TriMet bus line 15 also runs across the 6-lane bridge.

How does it open? The Morrison Bridge has a double-leaf bascule draw span which swings upward to provide clearance for boat traffic.

Fun Fact: Citizens can pay to have the 16 LED lights on the bridge's pier illuminated with color patterns of their choice for \$100 a night.
