

Children's Exposure to Violence Training Series

Offered by the Community Capacitation Center of Multnomah County Health Department in partnership with Multnomah County's Defending Childhood Initiative

Community Health Workers, Patient Navigators, Peer Wellness Specialists, Home Visitors, and others with similar, community-engaged roles are invited to attend training series to:

- Support parents, families, and caregivers to prevent, respond to, and help children recover from trauma associated with exposure to violence (such as community violence, bullying, and domestic violence);
- Help parents, families, and caregivers to strengthen healthy bonds with children; and
- Support communities that experience violence to build resiliency.

The series can be offered in English or Spanish. Cost is \$200 per person, which includes materials, lunch, and snacks, based on 25 participant attendance.
