Department solicitation and Department or Division description:

The Multnomah County Health Department Healthy Birth Initiatives (HBI) is seeking qualified candidates for a temporary position working to support the Community Action Network (CAN). The HBI CAN is developing a culturally specific strategic plan to eliminate disparities in birth outcomes for African American women and their families living in Multnomah County in addition to providing opportunities for HBI consumers and community partners to network, learn about community resources, and advocate for change.

Job Task Description:

This position will assist the Program Coordinator in the support of the HBI CAN. Tasks will include preparing for HBI CAN and related work group meetings, assisting with the strategic planning process and outreach and recruitment of new members, representing the HBI CAN at community events, and working to increase the program's social media and marketing efforts.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities Required:

- Knowledge of effective use of social media
- The ability to use logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems.
- The ability to communicate effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.
