







HB 3194 // Goal of Legislation


Maintain an effective and sustainable public safety system by directing savings that result from averted prison growth toward investments in our local communities.










HB 3194 // MCJRP Case Flow



Total Eligible Cases to Date 820




HB 3194 // 120 Day Supervision

- ✓ Group agrees on conditions resulting in 120 days of high level supervision.
- ✓ Court is notified of specific violations
- ✓ Specific Judges and Parole and Probation Officers are assigned to MCJRP
- ✓ Program provides upfront intensive resources
