Dear Mr. Delk:

We have reviewed your initiative petition paperwork, as to meeting the requirements to collect signatures, and have found it to be in order. You may begin collecting signatures for Initiative petition MultColnit-01.

Please use the approved forms on #20 white paper, as submitted. Each circulator must have a copy of the text available for review by petition signers. If you intend to mail the petition you must include a copy of the text with each mailing. A copy of the text must also be provided with every electronic signature sheet.

The deadline to collect a minimum of 23,174 signatures from registered voters in Multnomah County is six months from today's date, June 2, 2015. The deadline to turn in signatures would be December 2, 2015. Signature sheets must be submitted in one submission. All signature sheets must be numbered.
